

A Reflection on Love

1Cor. 13:1 If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. ² And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. ³ If I give away all I have, and if I deliver up my body to be burned, but have not love, I gain nothing.

- 4 Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant ⁵ or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; ⁶ it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. ⁷ Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.
- 8 Love never ends. As for prophecies, they will pass away; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will pass away. For we know in part and we prophesy in part, but when the perfect comes, the partial will pass away. When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I gave up childish ways. For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I have been fully known.
- **13** So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

Church Matters

In June 1988 the church building was finally completed (not without a few hitches like a coral coloured carpet being ordered to blend into the colour of the walls and a bright blue carpet, curiously with the same ID number, arriving). The fittings, doors, kitchen and painting were all completed by parishioners.

On the day of the commissioning, seating was laid out right up to the kitchen hatch. Even then there was standing room only.

The church was named Saint Francis of Assisi. Later it became Karrinyup Anglican Church as many in the wider community assumed that we were a Catholic church which proved to be quite confusing. There are a couple of references to the original name, in the church. The cross of St. Francis is incorporated in the stained glass window at the front of the church, and a small ornament of St Francis, brought back from Assisi by an early parishioner, is in a Perspex box by the sliding door on the Eastern side of the church.
