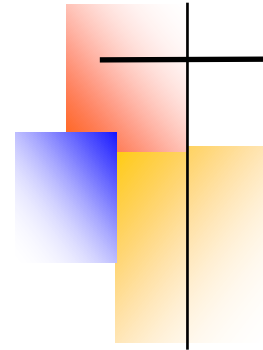

Lead us not into Temptation

A Christian psychologist wrote a book on the issue of guilt. Most of the issues could be traced back to matters of guilt, shame and regret. From the beginning human beings live their lives without regard for others and with the desire for self-rule as if we were God, our own arbiters of what is good and evil. The temptations of power, lust and greed continue to bring harm to so many especially the vulnerable and powerless.

Jesus faced such temptations after his baptism. The encounter here with Satan is explicit but I am sure the challenges he faced continued throughout his ministry. Hebrews reminds us though that he was able to resist temptation throughout all of his trials without succumbing.

Temptations often come to us in the midst of trial, whether momentary or enduring. Sometimes it is obvious and sometimes it is subtle. There are the struggles we are very aware of, others what we are blind to and others that find some self-justification. May God through his Spirit help us to both see and resist the temptations Satan throws our way.
