## The Christian's Dilemma

This next portion of Revelation serves as a dramatic visual reminder of both the gospel and the challenge Christians face in believing it. The bible is, in part, dualistic in that it presents us with a moral universe in which there is good and evil. It is not the kind of eastern dualism Star Wars typified that presents the two forces as equal and opposite but as St Augustine wrote in City of God, evil is a twisting of the good, whether the good things God has made, the good purpose for which they were made or the good motives by which we would usually act.

So this picture reminds us of the teaching of the Lord Jesus, the way the world responded to him and often responds to Christians. The history of martyrdom is one that is disturbing, bloody, and constant. Somewhere in the world Christians are suffering and dying for their faith. So what can we do? Firstly we need to be vigilant about the forces at work in our own country that use political correctness to silence Christian opponents and secondly we can, as we have in the past, be part of the Bible League's 'Bibles for the Persecuted' raising money for bibles to strengthen those who suffer in Jesus' name and who will one day be richly justified and blessed.
