Proclamation and Praise

On Thursday night I attended the installation of a friend and colleague as the Dean of St Andrew's Cathedral in Sydney. The service of evening prayer was a great encouragement, marked by an almost angelic choir, a good crowd including many from Western Australia and a solid sermon by the new Dean. Cathedrals are interesting places to serve in. We often think of grand architecture (though I've seen some very mediocre Cathedrals in my time) and ancient music. We think of a place for silence and contemplation and a centre for the life of a Diocese celebrating ordinations, consecrations and so on. Kanishka reminded us that like any church they are also places for proclamation, the proclamation of the gospel. In Christ we have been called, saved and gathered as a new people, a new community with Jesus as the cornerstone. That is true of St Andrews Cathedral, Sydney and it is true of St Francis, Karrinyup. We have been gathered together in Jesus, joined by the Spirit of God for proclamation and praise and for good reason, because through him we have been brought out of darkness into his marvellous light.
