Living for the Long Weekend???

Today we think about Jesus' baptism. Its significance for us is twofold. Firstly it is the beginning of Jesus' ministry as God's Son that will culminate in his death and exaltation. In this he does something only he can do as our mediator and saviour. In his baptism, though free from sin, he identifies himself with us in our humanity, in the face of sin, evil, death and judgment. He will endure them in order to save us from them.

Secondly it is the beginning of his ministry as the suffering servant. All who profess faith in him, who follow him are called to be servants of God and of others. We put others needs above our own wants so that they may grow in Christ. We understand that service involves all we do in each day, including our work. That stands out in a country that sees work as little more than a means to an end, to enabling our regular pursuit of leisure and relaxation over the weekend. We do need to rest but our work can serve a higher purpose than self-satisfaction. Jesus reminds us of this truth.
