## Revealing Revelation

Revelation is one of the most difficult books in the bible to read and understand. The imagery is vivid, provocative and at times confusing. The book over the centuries has become the purview of saints, sinners and psychopaths, studied by theologians, mystics, rock stars and criminals. Its genre is apocalyptic, containing visions of another world, a greater reality and unseen powers. So what lies at the heart of this book, this record of a most astonishing vision given to John, whom I take to be John the Apostle?

Firstly it was a letter written to churches struggling with possible persecution, apostasy and compromise. It is about living in light of the present conflict between the world and God's kingdom that will mark this age until the Lord returns. Many in the church have all but denied or given up on the idea of Jesus' return. We're familiar with the notion of apocalypse whether astronomical, economic, ecological, biological or military but this book reminds us of the spiritual when he will return and all will answer to him. More than that though it takes us forward to the day when our world will be paradise again as we live in the glorious light and love of God.
