

A World-Changing Sermon

This passage is in many regards one of the most important in all of Acts, as is shown by the enormous attention scholars have given it. For our purposes the passage is extremely significant because of what it reveals about Luke's purposes, approach and historian. We have noted repeatedly how Luke has arranged his material on the basis of geographical regions and ethnic groups. We have also repeatedly noted Luke's universalism – salvation is for all, for every sort of person. In this speech we have finally seen the connection between these two things.

It was God's plan to make from one human being the various groups or nations and to establish their boundaries, but it was also God's plan to unite all these different peoples into one people of God through Christ. Nevertheless, those who reject this good news must face the one final coming judgment also brought about by the same Christ. Paul Schubert puts it this way...“Luke regards the Areopagus speech as the final climactic part of his exposition of the whole plan of God.”
