

Over the next few weeks we're going to look at Paul's letter to the Colossians in two blocks. Colossi was a city which Paul may well not have gone to but he ministered throughout the region and a noted Colossian convert of his was Epaphras who heard him in Ephesus. He had been a significant influence on this church. The city of Colossi had been around for a good number of centuries before Paul arrived. In the 1<sup>st</sup> Century BC it had been a major city of commerce and trade lying at the crossroads of two major highways, trading wool in particular. By the 1<sup>st</sup> century one of the highways was moved north and the city lost its prime location, but it was still a vibrant, multicultural cosmopolitan city full of life and great cultural diversity. There was a significant Jewish population, but the bulk of the city were gentiles from all over. Colossians hints at the possibility that its religious mix included the so called 'mystery' religions akin to scientology and philosophies akin to the modern New Age movement. These stood in stark contrast to the gospel of Jesus Christ as we'll see.
