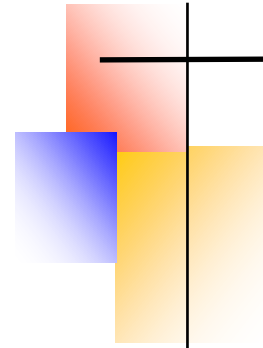

HISTORY OF CHAPLAINCY IN W.A.

In 1972, some 40 odd years ago, a diverse group of Christian churches set up a service which was focussed on guiding and supporting others by teaching moral values within the State School system.

Initially the group was called the Churches Commission on Education (CCE) and was committed to seeing CRE (Scripture) taught in public schools. Then in 1982 a chaplaincy programme was introduced into the Central Midlands Senior High School and Kelmscott Senior High School both of which still have Chaplains. The system was such a success that they have continued to build on that initial start.

Today the CRE volunteers undergo several months of training and mentoring so they can provide teaching of Christian beliefs, values and moral ethics.

The Federal Department of Education began supporting schools through the National Schools Chaplaincy Programme in 2007. This was updated in 2011 enabling YouthCare to increase the number of schools with Chaplains throughout the State.

The State government's involvement and the assistance of supporting churches has allowed the introduction of allied programmes which further develop the work of YouthCare and Chaplaincy.
